Day 1: May 27, 2025 Flight to Nashville, Tennessee- Hotel Stay

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Nashville, TN. Upon arrival, you will be met and transfered to your Nashville hotel. Settle into your hotel and explore this city at your leisure. From the legendary Grand Ole Opry to the Country Music Hall of Fame, Nashville is the official headquarters of country music. The lively streets are lined with art galleries and unique shops that welcome you at every turn. Take time to explore historic downtown, including the famous Country Music Hall of Fame Museum and Honky Tonk Row. In the evening, you will be treated to a show at the Grand Ole Opry!

Day 2: May 28, 2025 Cruising Lake Barkley and Cumberland River

It's embarkation Day! Board the American Symphony and get aquainted with your cabin and the ship. Admire the picturesque scenery of America's Heartland, including the Kentucky lakes and rolling landscape of 170,000 acres of protected forest. Experience a relaxing day cruising Lake Barkley and admire panoramic views of the Cumberland River from the comfort of your private balcony. Onboard, listen to engaging guest speakers who bring the river to life with stories of history and ecology of the region. Get to know fellow guests in one of the lounges or at the evening cocktail hour!

Day 3: May 29, 2025 Paducah, Kentucky

Situated at the confluence of the Tennessee River and the Ohio River, Paducah will make you feel as if you stepped back in time. Founded by William Clark (of Lewis and Clark), Paducah is known as a National Heritage Destination with many talented culinary artists, painters, potters, and jewelers creating and displaying their works there. Also known as "Quilt City", there is plenty to do in Paducah from shopping to visiting one of the many fine museums, to participating in a hands-on creative workshop at a local art gallery. At the heart of downtown, the National Quilt Museum celebrates Paducah's designation as a UNESCO Creative City of Crafts and Folk Art! Be sure to visit the Railroad Museum, featuring equipment and memorabilia from the romantic past of America's railroads.

Day 4: May 30, 2025 Savannah, Tennessee

Savannah is on the eastern shores of the Tennessee River. Part of Hardin County, Savannah is the largest city on the Tennessee River, with a well-preserved southern heritage and charm. Home to the nation's best-preserved battlefield, Shiloh National Military Park, the town also has a rich Civil War history. Admire the city's historic district, featuring 42 unique homes, including the Cherry Mansion which served as the headquarters of General Ulysses S. Grant at the time of the Battle of Shiloh. At the heart of Savannah, the Tennessee River Museum offers an engaging chronicle of the river's integral role in shaping regional history, from ancient Native American settlements to the golden age of steamboats. Other points of interest include the Savannah Theater, Savannah Cemetery, and recently revitalized Main Street.

Day 5: May 31, 2025 Florence, Alabama

Deeply enriched with history, blues, culture, and natural beauty, Florence is filled with character alongside the Tennesse River. Here, where you can walk along part of the Trail of Tears, you will find the Rosenbaum House--the Alabama structure designed by architect Frank Lloyd Wright. Experience the "Muscle Shoals Sound" resonating in the air of the birthplace of W.C. Handy, known as the "Father of the Blues." A festive town, you can join in on the celebration during one of the many festivals held in Florence, including the Alabama Renassaince Faire, the Trail of Tears Celebration, Frontier Days Celebration, and the Arts Alive Celebration. Guests can scour the wilderness by fishing in the many rivers and lakes of the area, taking in the scenery of the many parks and trails, or golfing at one of the public or private courses on a warm afternoon. Florence is one of four cities that make up "the Shoals", an area spanning two counties and divided by the Tennessee River. Explore the charming downtown, with locally owned stores featuring everything from handmade jewelry and bohemian chic fashion to antique collectables. Stop at The Wine Seller for a tasting or sip Java at the popular Bookmarks Coffee Shop in the public library. There are a variety of venues in which to enjoy live entertainment as well!

Day 6: June 1, 2025 Decatur, Alabama

Decatur's historical significance lies in its location along the Tennessee River. Once a river crossing, 1836 marked the year Decatur became the eastern end-point for the first rail line west of the Appalachian Mountains. Decatur played an important role in the Civil War because of the town's rail system, which was used by the opposing army in attempts to seize the railroad. By the end of the Civil War, Decatur had been all but destroyed--only three buildings remained intact; the rest were incinerated. Today citizens and visitors of Decatur take advantage of the plethora of outdoor recreational activities the city has to offer, many of them water-related, such as boating, fishing, and water skiing. Also, visit the Old State Bank for a look into Civil War era architecture and decor. Southern charm abounds in the Old Decatur Historic District. Admire houses built from the 1800s to the present, ranging in style from the French-influenced Empire period to Edwardian Cottage and beyond. On your way, peruse the many unique shops found along Bank Street and 2nd Avenue. Visit the fascinating museums, including the Cook Museum of Natural Science, the Carnegie Visual Arts Center, and the U.S. Space & Rocket Center.

Day 7: June 2, 2025 Cruising the Tennessee River

Sail through the Appalachian Mountains, following the gentle curves of the river framed by grand scenery. As your journey unfolds, delight in the onboard musicians who fill the air with tunes as timeless as the river itself. Join us for complimentary drinks during our nightly cocktail hour to engage with fellow passengers and our friendly crew, each sharing stories and smiles!

Day 8: June 3, 2025 Chattanooga, Tennessee

Nestled between the mountains of Southeast Tennessee, along the scenic Tennessee River, Chattanooga is one of America's most splendid cities. 
